ADDITIONAL WARNING: Once exposed, the desire to dye fabric may be addictive! ☺

SUPPLY LIST

Please bring the following items:

- An empty 2-liter bottle with the top cut off (allowing your hand to easily fit inside).
- A gallon of water (empty milk jug with tap water is great!)
- Two plastic basins:
 - One at least 4” high, 8” wide, and 8-12” long
 - Another at least 6-8” high, 12 - 15” wide, and 12-15” long (a plastic sink basin would be great!!!)
- An inexpensive plastic one- or two-cup liquid measure*
- An inexpensive set of plastic measuring spoons*
 - *you will not be able to use these for food prep after the class!
- Fine-tipped Sharpie pen
- Pencil / pen and paper for notes
- One (commercial) bag of ice - Sonic ice is preferred and works great!!

NOTE: Additional fabric kits (1 ½ yds. fabric, prepared for dyeing, plus all dyes, baggies, etc.) will be **available for purchase** during the workshop for your dyeing pleasure (for additional gradations or multi-colored layer technique). **Be sure to bring one extra 2-liter bottle for each additional multi-colored layer set you wish to create.**
