

Fabric Dyeing & Surface Design Fundamentals

Warning: *wear clothes that you won't mind if they get dye-stained!!*

Additional warning: *The fabric dyeing experience may become habit-forming!!*

SUPPLY LIST

- An empty 2-liter bottle with enough of the top cut off that your hand will fit inside.
- 1 gallon of tap water (an empty milk jug works great!)
- One 5-10 lb. bag of "Sonic" ice: fairly finely crushed ice (please bring in a cooler as we have limited freezer space)
- Two plastic bins
 - One approx. 4" x 8" x 8 - 12"
 - One 6 - 8" high x 12 - 15" square or rectangular
 - (a plastic "sink basin" works great)
- An inexpensive 1-2 Cup liquid measuring cup *
- An inexpensive set of plastic measuring spoons
 - (1/8 tsp, 1/4 tsp, 1/2 tsp, 1 tsp, 1 tablespoon) *
 - * You will NOT be able to use these for food prep after class!!
- A black ultra fine-tip Sharpie pen
- Paper and pen/pencil for notes

NOTE: A limited number of additional 1 1/2 yard "kits" (includes dye use, baggies, etc.) will be available for purchase during class if you wish to make additional gradations or multi-colored layered pieces. Bring extra empty 2-liter bottles (cut as described above) for any additional multi-colored sets you wish to do!
